MAKE YOUR OWN MASK

Materials:

1 x pc. of plain 100% cotton fabric (internal face), 25x20cm 1 x pc. of 100% cotton fabric (ext. face), 25x20cm 2 x strips of cotton jersey fabric - approx. 50cm long

Instructions:

- 1. To make the i cord, cut a strip of jersey approx.2cm wide x 50cm long. Grab each end and pull firmly.
- 2. Place the 2 large pieces of fabric back to back with the wrong sides together, and neaten (zigzag) all four sides, thus joining them together.
- 3. Fold top and bottom edges of 25cm sides down by approx. 1cm and hem.
- 4. Fold each 20cm side into the white internal side by approx 2cm and stitch close to the neatened seam, to create a channel each side for the cord.
- 5. Thread a cord through each side channel on the 20cm sides and pull to gather. Your mask is now finished.

Care Instructions:

100% cotton will enable the masks to be washed at 60° or higher. This is the recommended temperature for all hospital wear to sanitise items for reuse multiple times.

Jersey instead of elastic cord will give you extra comfort.
